- Discussed tenure for NTTs. Provost is reconstituting the Strategic Initiatives
 Committee, and this may be one of the pillars from that committee
- EC presented its priorities from the shared governance recommendations: Collegial Assemblies; Deans' reviews matrix; faculty board member or shared faculty/board committee. Fourth priority is the Ombudsperson.

A discussion/explanation of the four priorities of shared governance followed.

Discussion of the upcoming revision of Faculty Senate Constitution and the possible inclusion of adjuncts into the Faculty Senate. There was extensive discussion of the issue. It was determined that it should remain on the agenda, and it was suggested that the newly created committee on adjunct constituency could address some of the issues and possible solutions once the committee is populated.

Faculty discount for sports events: Will faculty still be interested with a 20% discount and deducted from salary? It was suggested that the process be done more informally. Additional options were suggested. The president will take these ideas back to Arthur Johnson.
