- In May of 2020, I circulated Temple administration's "Return Team" documents among the committee members.
- In September of 2020, I forwarded Quaiser Abdullah's concerns about Temple's reopening procedures to Steve Newman and TAUP's Tenure Track Constituency Committee, as TAUP had been discussing those issues, as well.
- Also, in September, I circulated to the committee members Quaiser Abdullah's letter to the BOT concerning the lack of diversity in Temple's presidential search, with the hope of persuading them to add more members to the search committee.
- I asked the members to poll their departmental colleagues regarding both of these issues: Temple's reopening procedures and the composition of the BOT's presidential search committee.
- In January of 2021, I circulated to TAUP a brief summary of Ken Kaiser's presentation to the Faculty Senate on the budget and facilitated Donald Wargo's (Chair of the Budget Committee) attendance at Ken's presentation to the FSSC at our Feb. 2 meeting.
